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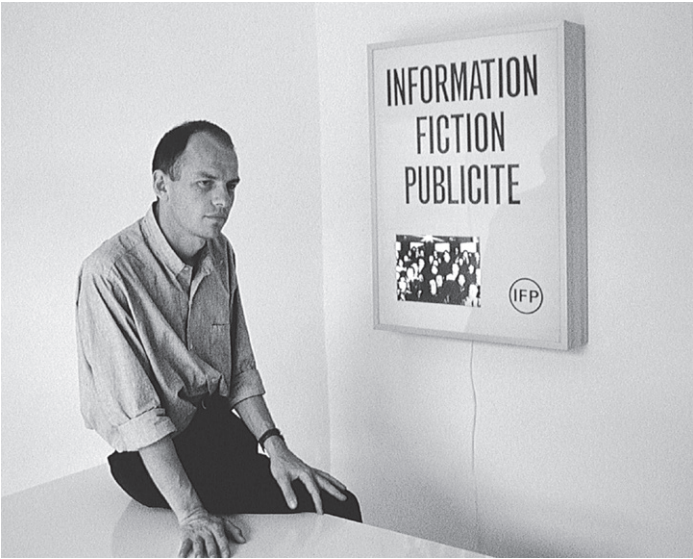

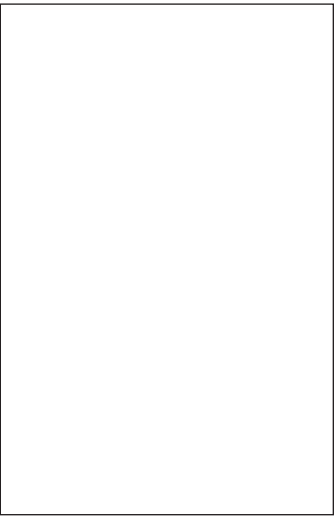


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GENEVA, MAR. 16 – The exhibition *Uniques. Notebooks written, drawn, nonprinted* at the Fondation Martin Bodmer in Geneva displays unpublished and unique notebooks and diaries of artists, writers and philosophers such as Arthur Schopenhauer, Jorge Luis Borges, Marcel Proust, Isaac Newton, Stéphane Mallarmé, Walter Benjamin and Henri Michaux and includes notebooks by **Philippe Thomas**, on loan from the Bibliothèque Kandinsky in Paris. BASEL, MAR. 9 – **Pierre Bismuth** is developing a new series of works titled *Abstractions* to be shown for the first time in Art Basel Parcours in June. The project consists in the creation of new flag emblems, obtained by the superimposition of two existing national flags and is inspired by the present migratory movements towards Europe: one flag being the emblem of a migrant's country of origin, the second one being the one of a hypothetical European host country. Flags mark territories and nations, categories that still remain stable points of reference today. Here the creation of a symbol made out of the merging of two national flags seems to establish a permanent sign for a major phenomenon which outcome remains totally unknown. GHENT, MAR. 15 – S.M.A.K in Ghent is celebrating its 20th anniversary with the exhibition *The Collection (1), Highlights for a Future*, presenting 200 works from the collection and occupying the entire space of the museum. MEXICO CITY, MAR. 15 – Since 2016 Francis Aliy has been working on a complex ensemble of videos, paintings, drawings, found objects etc. which were produced in Mosul and in refugee camps in the province of Duhok in collaboration with the Yazidi community. The image above relates to the video entitled *Salam tristesse* and pictures one of two older men filmed during their tender encounter with a horse. Filmed at night, the mere presence of the horse allows the men to unleash their emotions and express the disillusion with humanity. The ensemble explores numerous themes, both historic and contemporary in the larger “story” of Iraq, from the creation of the nation at the beginning of the 20th century against an Anglo-French colonial background, to the American encounter, and its impact on the geographic unravelling of the Iraqi state with the war, by and against ISIS since 2014. The project is realised upon the invitation of the Ruya Foundation.

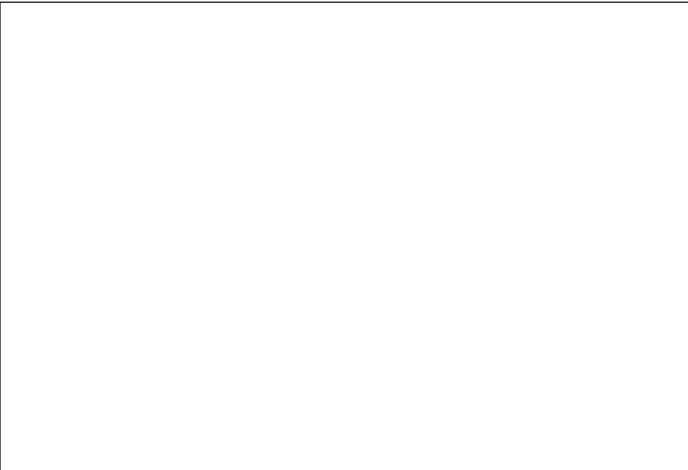
